

**HANJ Wine Tasting Gourmet Dinner:  
A spectacular tasting of some of Burgundy's top producers**

White Wines

**2004 Domaine William Fevre Chablis Les Preuses Grand Cru**

*Green fruit and citrus aromas with a subtle trace of quinine serve to highlight round, sweet and powerful flavors that possess enormous depth of material and the vibrancy of the finish is flat out unbelievable. In a sense, this is a deceptive wine in that no more than the finish appears to be winding down then it picks up again. At present, this is the longest and most persistent wine in the range and while this aspect is subject to change with time, it is a dazzling effort that vies credibly for top honors. I could still taste this wine the next day! Alan Meadows*

**2000 Domaine Colin-Deleger Puligny Montrachet Premier Cru**

*A worthy successor to the fantastic 1999 Demoiselles with its knockout aromas of peach, white flowers and a hint of pain grillé that lead to fine yet powerful, deeply complex flavors in a relatively forward style. Very long and incredibly persistent, this has impressive cellar potential! Alan Meadows*

Red Wines

**1999 Domaine Anne Gros Chambolle Musigny La Combe d'Orveau Villages Red**

*50% new oak and yields of 40/hl/ha. Good density of fruit and flavors with nice spice, supple tannins and quality length. Solid if not exceptional villages. Alan Meadows.*

**2001 Domaine Hubert Lignier Morey St. Denis Villages Red**

*Much bigger and richer with more structure, more buffering sap and much more weight and volume. This too is really lovely and precise and displays fine balance and a very dry finish but it's not quite as perfumed and sweet in the mouth as the Chambolle. Alan Meadows*

**1995 Domaine Fourrier Gevrey Chambertin Combe Aux Moines Premier Cru**

*A great vintage. From the beginning, Jean-Marie has demonstrated his brilliance in working with this dominating terroir. Made from 67-year-old vines, the '95 is a wine of both grace and power. The Rare Wine Company.*

**2001 Domaine Hubert Lignier Chambolle Musigny Premier Cru**

*Good ruby red color with fresh, pretty cherry pinot fruit and extremely fine, almost delicate flavors that display excellent precision if not great weight. This is finesse personified with lovely acid/fruit balance and has added weight since it was bottled. A really lovely effort at this level and classic Chambolle in character! Alan Meadows*

**2002 Domaine Jacques-Frederic Mugnier Bonnes-Mares Grand Cru**

*Ultra elegant and high-toned red and black fruit aromas cut with obvious earth notes are followed by rich, full-bodied flavors that are sappy yet edgy, all culminating in a powerful and punchy finish. The aspect that impresses me the most however is the impeccable balance. In short, a gorgeous wine. Alan Meadows.*

**1997 Domaine Louis Jadot Grand Echezeaux Grand Cru**

*Profound red cherry and rose aromas are found in the aromatics of the medium to dark ruby-colored 1997 Grands-Echezeaux. Baked mixed berries and Asian spices are found in this velvety-textured, wide, super-rich, rather thick wine. Medium to full-bodied, highly concentrated, and judiciously extracted, it is hugely flavorful and opulent, yet well-structured. This exceptional wine should be at its peak of maturity between 2002-2012. Pierre Rovani.*

*Winemaker Louis Jadot claims that this wine is one of the greatest wines he has ever made.*

**2003 Doisy-Vedrines Groffier Sauternes**

*Bright yellow-gold. Spicy, ripe, complex aromas of peach, apricot, orange and nutmeg. Juicy, shapely and sweet, with lovely inner-mouth lift and aromatic character. High-toned and expressive but also quite fresh and precise for the year. Finishes impressively long and firm. A very strong performance for this chateau, and a good value. Steve Tanzer.*
